# Presumptive conditions for Gulf War era and Post-911 Veterans

# Ill for at least six months and resulted in at least 10% disability rating:

- Functional gastrointestinal disorders (Irritable Bowel Syndrome, Dyspepsia, Vomiting, Constipation, Bloating, Abdominal Pain Syndrome, Dysphagia, or other conditions)
- ♦ Chronic fatigue syndrome
- ♦ Fibromyalgia
- Other undiagnosed illnesses, including but not limited to cardiovascular disease, muscle and joint pain, and headaches

### Diagnosed within one year after date of separation:

- Brucellosis
