

**BURLEIGH COUNTY WEED BOARD
MEETING MINUTES
JULY 7th, 2025**

5:40 PM

Chairman Bakken called the Burleigh County Weed Board meeting to order.

Roll call of the members: Commissioners Bitner, Munson, Schwab, Woodcox, and Chairman Bakken present.

Motion by Comm. Bitner, 2nd by Comm. Woodcox to approve the agenda. All members present voted 'AYE'.
Motion carried.

Motion by Comm. Woodcox, 2nd by Comm. Schwab to approve the May 5th, 2025 meeting minutes. All members present voted 'AYE'. ***Motion carried.***

County Weed Officer Daron Johnson gave an update on the County's weed control program. He stated that between twenty-seven and thirty townships had been sprayed. Johnson said that he had received forty applications for contracted spraying of private land. From May 1st through June 26th, chemical distribution occurred on Thursdays between 11:00am and 1:00pm and approximately fifty people picked up chemicals for self-application. Johnson said that he had been giving township officers notification of spraying ahead of time and to also let them know to have landowners mark areas of increased infestation. He stated that he purchased chemicals ahead of the anticipated chemical price increase. Johnson said that the County had three spray trucks: two with SpraySync and one without. The one without the SpraySync is tracking the activity manually and then logging it into the system. Johnson stated that when the trucks are out spraying, they are covering the gravel pits as well. He did note that weed complaints have been minimal, but the weeds haven't started blooming yet. Johnson said he got four bags of brown and black beetles which have been placed mainly around the Hogue Island area to eat the weeds along with some red-headed bores.

Chairman Bakken called the Burleigh County Weed Board meeting to order.

Roll call of the members: Commissioners Bitner, Munson, Schwab, Woodcox, and Chairman Bakken present.

Motion by Comm. Munson, 2nd by Comm. Bitner to approve the agenda. All members present voted 'AYE'.
Motion carried.

Motion by Comm. Schwab, 2nd by Comm. Munson to approve the January 21st, 2025 meeting minutes. All members present voted 'AYE'. ***Motion carried.***

County Weed Officer Daron Johnson enumerated updates on the weed program. He stated the self-application form for chemical sales started on May 1st, 2025 and he will continue selling until June 26th, 2025 on Thursdays from 11:00am to 1:00pm. Johnson said that he has received a lot of interest in the contract spraying. He listed Milestone and High Noon as the chemicals that are being applied this year. Johnson stated the County purchased SpraySync in 2023 and is getting the system set up for use in conjunction with the NDDA. SpraySync will be out this year to install the system on the trucks and NDDA Inspector Derek Woehl will be present with the operators to do a mock inspection on the equipment. He said Woehl would also be coming out to the distribution center to make sure everything looks good. Johnson stated that the contract has been signed with NDDOT for state highway spraying.
