

## **Presumptive conditions for Gulf War era and Post-911 Veterans**

### ***Ill for at least six months and resulted in at least 10% disability rating:***

- ◆ Functional gastrointestinal disorders (Irritable Bowel Syndrome, Dyspepsia, Vomiting, Constipation, Bloating, Abdominal Pain Syndrome, Dysphagia, or other conditions)
- ◆ Chronic fatigue syndrome
- ◆ Fibromyalgia
- ◆ Other undiagnosed illnesses, including but not limited to cardiovascular disease, muscle and joint pain, and headaches

### ***Diagnosed within one year after date of separation:***

- ◆ Brucellosis
- ◆ Campylobacter jejuni
- ◆ Coxiella burnetii (Q fever)
- ◆ Nontyphoid salmonella
- ◆ Shigella
- ◆ West Nile Virus
- ◆ Malaria

### ***Diagnosed any time after separation:***

- ◆ Mycobacterium tuberculosis
- ◆ Visceral leishmaniasis
- ◆ Brain cancer
- ◆ Gastrointestinal cancer of any type
- ◆ Glioblastoma
- ◆ Head cancer of any type
- ◆ Kidney cancer
- ◆ Lymphatic cancer of any type
- ◆ Lymphoma of any type
- ◆ Melanoma
- ◆ Neck cancer of any type
- ◆ Pancreatic cancer
- ◆ Reproductive cancer of any type
- ◆ Respiratory (breathing-related) cancer of any type
- ◆ Asthma diagnosed after service
- ◆ Chronic bronchitis
- ◆ COPD
- ◆ Chronic rhinitis
- ◆ Chronic sinusitis
- ◆ Constrictive bronchiolitis or obliterative bronchiolitis
- ◆ Emphysema
- ◆ Granulomatous disease
- ◆ Interstitial lung disease
- ◆ Pleuritis
- ◆ Pulmonary fibrosis
- ◆ Sarcoidosis

If you served in any of these locations and time periods, it is presumed that you had exposure to burn pits or other toxins.

**On or after September 11, 2001, in any of these locations:**
