Sealed electronic bids will be OPENED and READ publicly at 10:00 AM Local Time, at the Burleigh County Highway Department in Bismarck, ND. Bids received after 10:00 AM will not be considered. Bids must be submitted electronically through BidVAULT. A link to the bid opening will be posted prior to the bid date.

The results and final disposition of the bid opening will be presented to the County Commission on Monday, April 6, 2026, beginning approximately at 5:00 PM (Local Time), in the Tom Baker room of the City/County building located at 221 N 5th Street, Bismarck, ND.

TYPE OF WORK: Crushing of Roadway Gravel and Aggregates

Proposed work includes producing and processing of roadway gravel. All materials and procedures will be in accordance with the most current version of the NDDOT Standard Specifications for Road & Bridge Construction, and all supplemental material.

All bids must be upon the basis of cash payment for the work and materials.
