**SIBLEY PARK STARTED
FROM JUBILEE PROFIT**



- June 5, 1973 – Burleigh County Park Board submitted project information for development of "Driscoll Sibley Park"
- October 30, 1973 – Allan E. Whitman sold the land (@ 2 acres) for development of a new park area
- 1973-1974 – Park developed (landscaping, picnic tables, picnic shelter, garbage receptacles, comfort station, fencing) with grant assistance from Land and Water Conservation Fund Act (Project 38-00415)
- 1975 – Driscoll Men's Club built outdoor fireplace from cement blocks and faced it with native rock
- 1978 – Well Drillers Unit #916 of the Army Reserve from Bismarck drilled a 4" well with grant assistance from the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act (Project 38-00724)
- 1979 – Club built another picnic shelter and two picnic tables. The Driscoll Township Board graveled the parking area.
- 1980 – Wooden Windmill erected (1979 donation by Monty Dralle, Sterling) and water tank installed.
